- Aims to support small, grass roots organisations who are embedded in the community, working within the most deprived areas of the UK
- The grant programme provides running costs grants for established organisations
- Funding is for organisations that provide services which are widely accessible to the whole community and respond to, and address the needs of the people living in it

Funding Covers:	Running costs
Organisation Type:	Community-led charities and not for profit organisations

## **Example Grant: Ingol and Tanterton Community Trust**



Ingol and Tanterton Community Trust (Intact) is a grassroots community organisation based in Ingol, Preston. The area is among England's 7% most deprived areas.

The people Intact support are vulnerable, socially isolated adults. Intact delivers multiple services from its community centre, including: a food bank and community pantry, drop-in and 1-1 support, welfare and debt advice, work clubs, volunteering opportunities and community events. Intact responded to the COVID-19 crisis by distributing food parcels locally and donating IT devices to the digitally excluded.

Grant awarded: £163,200 over 3 years (funding from 2019 to 2022)
