- Increasing Environmental Sustainability

Projects must be community-led and should demonstrate one or more of the following characteristics:

- Working towards a long-term vision
- Facilitating connectedness and collaboration
- Demonstrating innovation

Applicants will need to send a short video and complete a simple 'Expression of Interest' form on the RCF website.
